

On April 19, 2007, we broke ground for Phase I of our \$90 million expansion project, which features a new 500+ space parking garage, new Medical Office Building and a new patient tower. Phase II will convert semi-private rooms in the current tower into private rooms and renovate the Women's Health Pavilion, the North Lobby and other ancillary departments.

Our new patient tower features an Emergency Department that is triple the size of the former department; a new second floor Medical-Surgical/Telemetry Unit; a new 24-bed Intensive Care Unit; and a new fourth floor Telemetry/Progressive Care Unit. All rooms in the new patient tower are completely private for the patient's comfort and well-being.

I appreciate your patience during this expansion and am very excited to welcome you to the new patient tower at Phoenixville Hospital. I understand that there may be some confusion as a number of departments have moved into the new patient tower. Therefore, I hope the map in this brochure will help you navigate our campus. 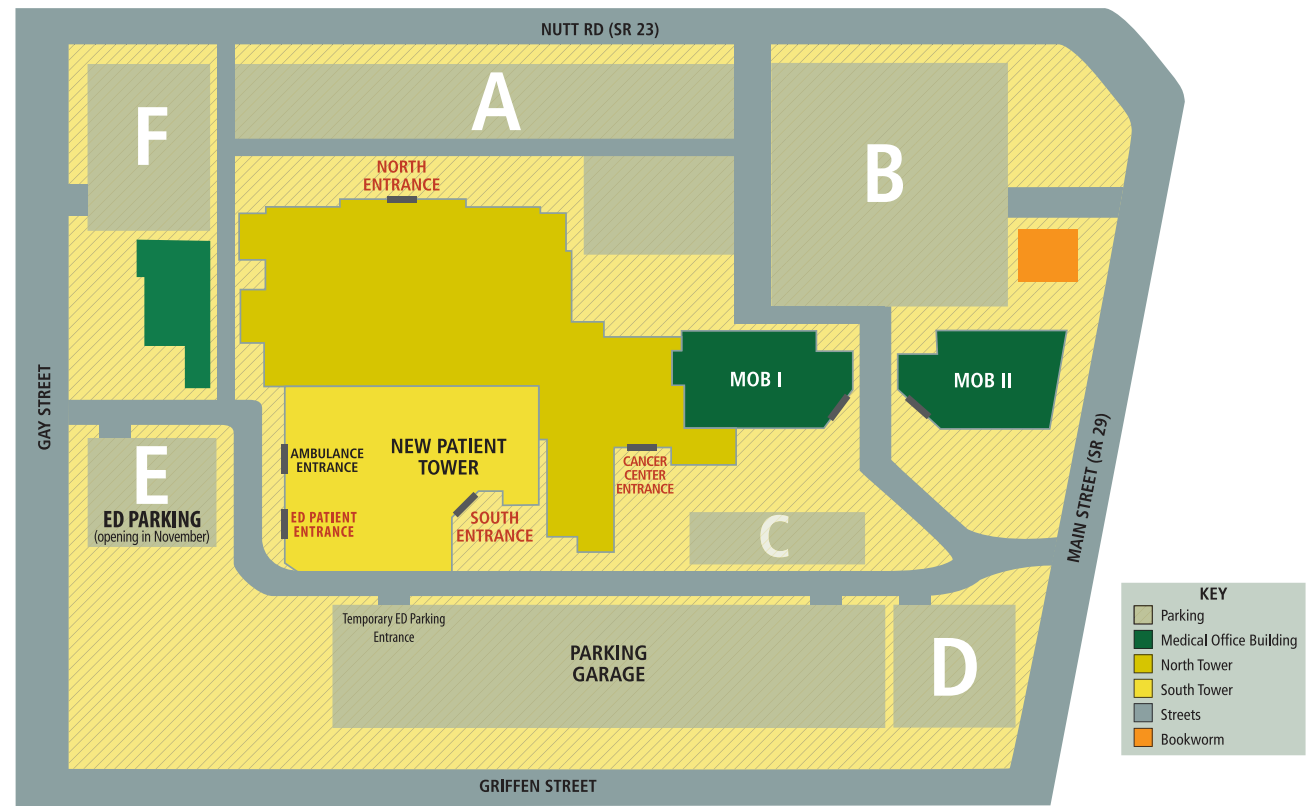
